### **EAST HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL STANDON FOOTPATH No. 25 SECTION 257 DIVERSION ORDER 2015**

The above order was made on 28 January 2015. The effect of this order will be to divert the public footpath running from Old Hall Green at TL 36970 21990 generally west, south of the tennis courts, for approximately 100 metres to TL 36870 21990. Continuing generally west north west for approximately 140 metres to a junction with Kettle Green at TL 36730 22020 to a line running from a junction with Kettle Green at TL 36730 22020 running generally south east for approximately 120 metres to TL 36795 21916 then continuing generally east for approximately 190 metres to a junction with Old Hall Green at TL 36984 21921.

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan may be seen free of charge at East Hertfordshire District Council from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the Order and plan may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

Any representation about or objections to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Mrs L Blackburn, Democratic Services Officer, East Hertfordshire District Council, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford SG13 8EQ not later than 8 March 2015. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the East Hertfordshire District Council may itself confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.

DIVERSION ORDER 2015

This Order is made by East Hertfordshire District Council ('the authority') under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the Footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. Planning permission for the development affecting the Footpath was granted by East Hertfordshire District Council on 2 May 2014 under reference 3/14/0437/FP.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The footpath over the land shown by the bold black line on the attached plan ('the Order Plan') and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of East Hertfordshire District Council an alternative highway for the use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached Order Plan.
3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which East Hertfordshire District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.
4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: The instillation of culverts, or similar structure, at TL 3676 2195 and TL 36984 21921.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of path or way

The full width of that part of Standon Footpath 25 running from a junction with Old Hall Green at TL 36970 21990 (Point A on the Order Plan) generally west, south of the tennis courts, for approximately 100 metres to TL 36870 21990 (Point B on the Order Plan). Continuing generally west north west for approximately 140 metres to a junction with Kettle Green at TL 36730 22020 (Point C on the Order Plan).

PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

A public Footpath commencing at a junction with Kettle Green at TL 36730 22020 (Point C on the Order Plan) running generally south east for approximately 120 metres to TL 36795 21916 (Point D on the Order Plan) then continuing generally east for approximately 190 metres to a junction with Old Hall Green at TL 36984 21921 (Point E on the Order Plan).

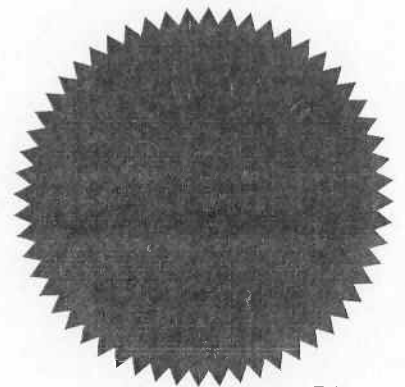
