

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH ORDER**

On 21 October 2016 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert part of Buntingford Footpath 12 running from TL 3658 2959 generally south east to a junction with Hare Street Road at TL 3678 2942 to a line running from TL 3658 2959 generally south east, through the open space adjacent to the play area, then following the new footways to a junction with Hare Street Road at TL 3677 2941.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen at the Council Offices, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford and Charringtons House, The Causeway, Bishop's Stortford and may be inspected free of charge at the reception desks between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on weekdays. Copies of the order and map may be purchased.

This order comes into force on the date on which East Hertfordshire District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
