

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

EAST HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

DIVERSION ORDER 2019

This Order is made by East Hertfordshire District Council ('the authority') under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the bridleway to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: planning permission for the development affecting the bridleway which was granted by East Hertfordshire District Council on 27 April 2017 under reference 3/17/0002FUL.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The bridleway over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached plan ('the Order Plan') and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of East Hertfordshire District Council an alternative highway for the use as a replacement for the said bridleway as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached Order Plan.
3. The diversion of the bridleway shall have effect on the date on which East Hertfordshire District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 have been complied with.
4. Where immediately before the date on which the bridleway is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path or bridleway

The full width of that part of Widford bridleway 16 running from TL 4126 1584 (Point A on the Order Plan) generally westwards for approximately 40 metres to TL 4122 1583 (Point B on the Order Plan), then turning southwards and continuing for approximately 20 metres to TL 4122 1581 (Point C on the Order Plan).

PART 2

Description of site of alternative bridleway

A public bridleway commencing at a junction with Widford bridleway 16 at TL 4126 1584 (Point A on the Order Plan) running generally west north west for approximately 15 metres to TL 4124 1584 (Point D on the Order Plan) then continuing generally south west for approximately 40 metres to a junction with Widford Bridleway 16 at TL 4122 1581 (Point C on the Order Plan).

Width: 5 metres

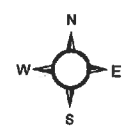

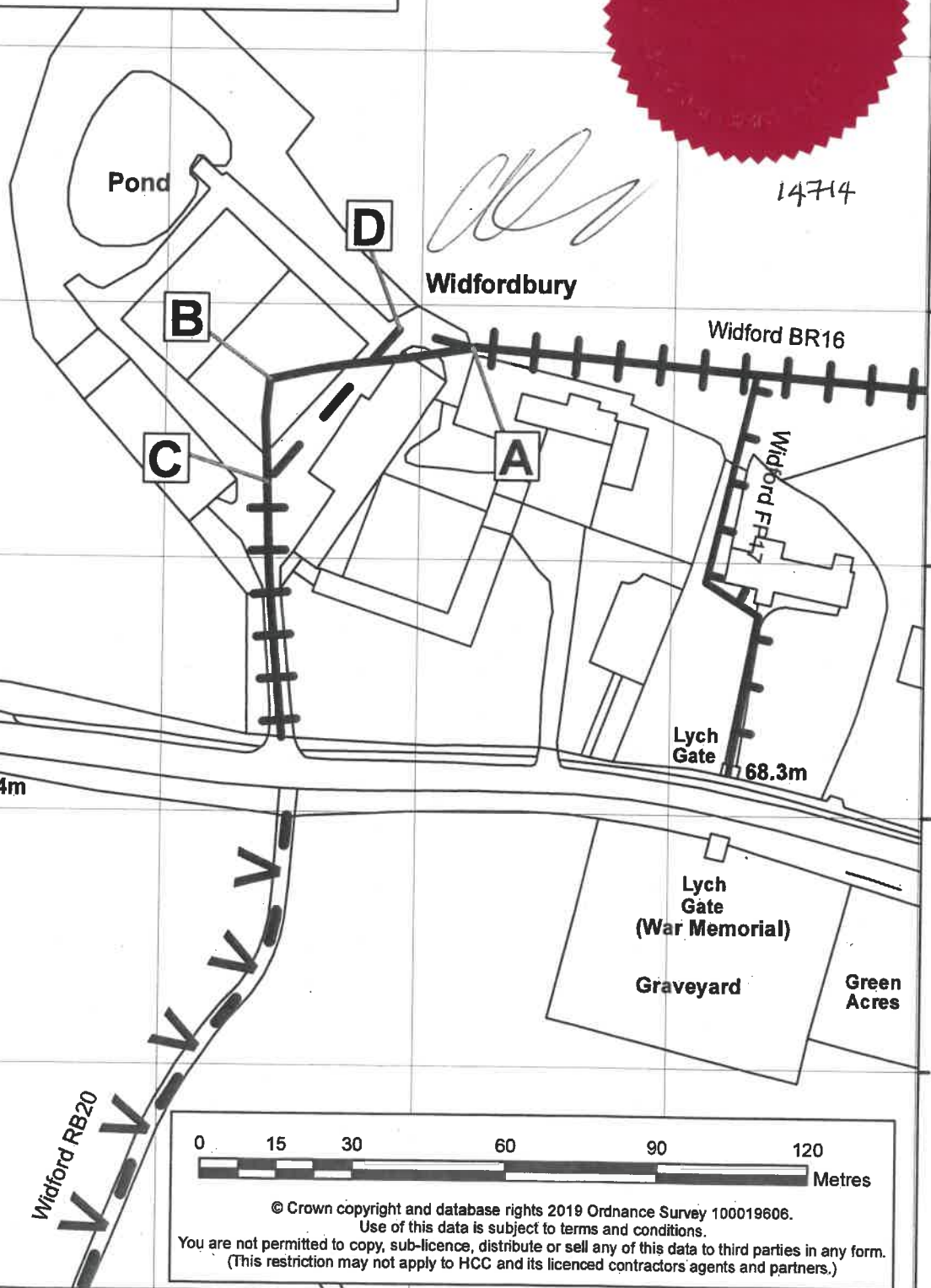

DIVERSION ORDER 2019

The above order was made on 14 May 2019. The effect of this order will be to divert the public bridleway running from TL 4126 1584 generally west and south for approximately 60 metres to TL 4122 1581 to a line running from a junction with Widford bridleway 16 at TL 4126 1584 running generally west north west for approximately 15 metres to TL 4124 1584 then continuing generally south west for approximately 40 metres to a junction with Widford Bridleway 16 at TL 4122 1581 as shown on the order map.

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan may be seen free of charge at East Herts District Council from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the Order and plan may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

Any representation about or objections to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to Mrs L Blackburn, Democratic Services Officer East Hertfordshire District Council, Wallfields, Pegs Lane, Hertford SG13 8EQ not later than 19 June 2019. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, East Hertfordshire District Council may itself confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
